


- 1. Prise the handbrake cable from its clip and the spring from its pan.
- 2. Remove the arm from the vehicle and press out the original bush.
- 3. Clean any dirt or burrs from the bore in the arm, removing any sharp edges with a rounded file.
- 4. Push the bushes into either side of the arm, shown in Figure 1.
- 5. Apply some of the supplied PTFE/Silicone grease to the bore and the mounting faces of each bush.
- 6. Press the Stainless-Steel sleeve into the bushes until flush.
- 7. The washers should be fitted to the outside of the top hats to support the bush face, shown in Figure 2.
- 8. Refit the arm to the vehicle with spring etc. and tension all hardware to the manufacturer's recommended torque settings.
